

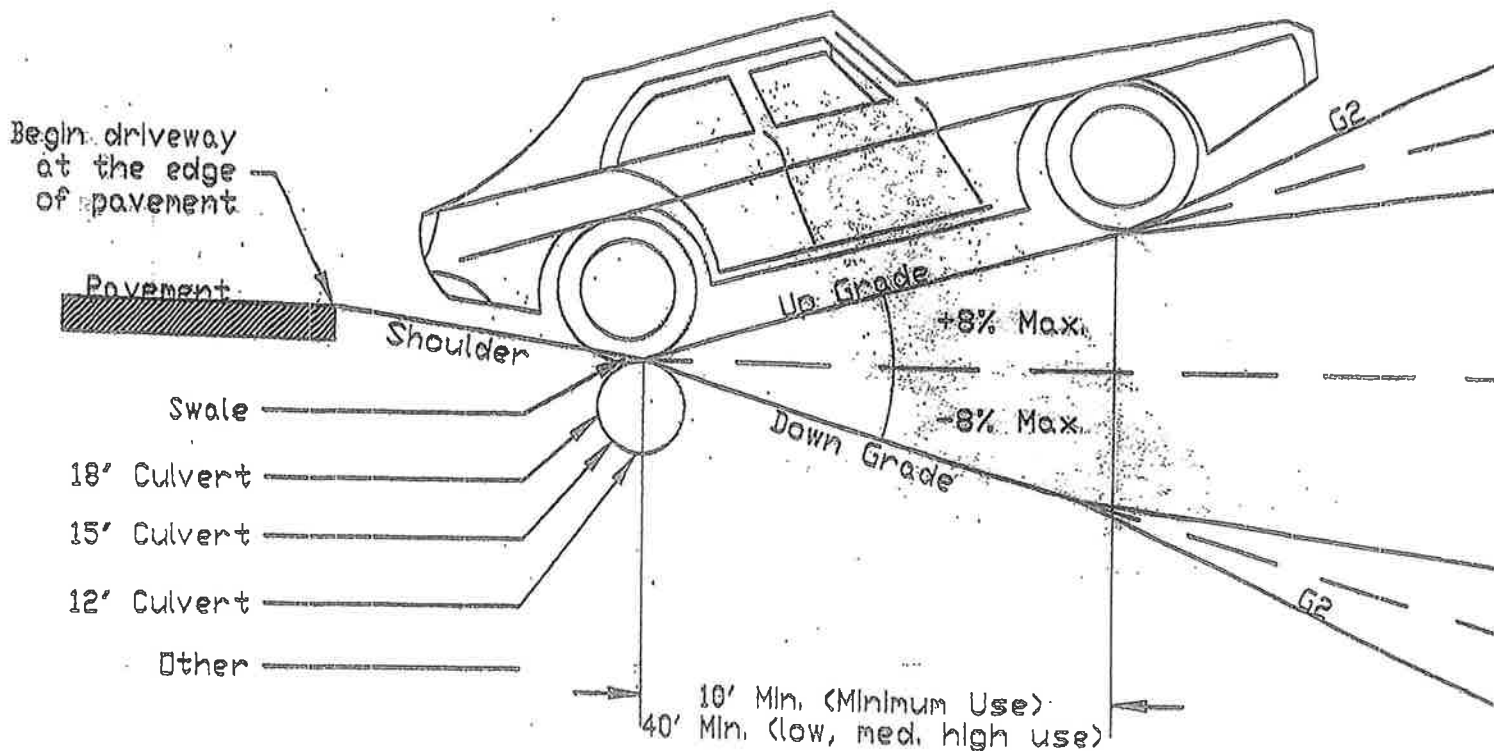

The shoulder slopes usually varies from 1/2' /ft. (4%) to 3/4' /ft. (6%). However the shoulder slope should be maintained when constructing the driveway.

Grades (G2) shall be limited to 15% (approx. 2"/ft.) for minimum use driveways and from five percent to eight percent for low, medium or high volume driveways within the right-of-way.

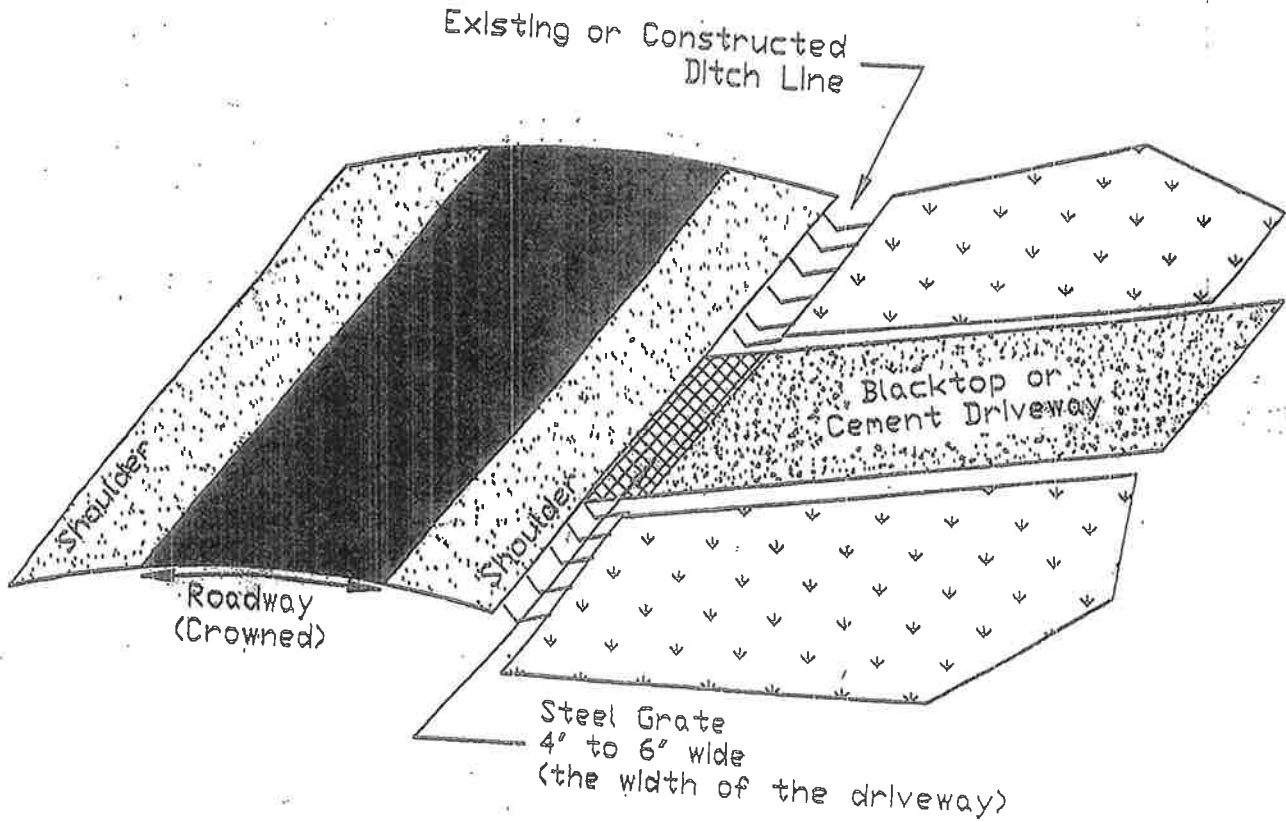
All driveways shall be constructed so as not to impair drainage within the right-of-way, alter the stability of the improved area, or change the drainage of adjacent areas.

When a drainage ditch or swale exists, the permittee shall install adequate pipe under the driveway. Drainage pipes installed under driveway shall be at least 12 inches in diameter.

All driveways shall be located, designed, constructed, and maintained in such a manner as not to interfere or be inconsistent with the design, maintenance and drainage of the highway.

- Access driveways shall be permitted at locations in which:
1. Sight distance is adequate to safely allow each permitted movement to be made into or out of access driveway.
  2. The free movement of normal highway traffic is not impaired.
  3. The driveway will not create a hazard and
  4. The driveway will not create an area of undue traffic congestion on the highway.

\*\*\*\*If driveway is paved, please have new Driveway Permit issued by the township. New pavement may change the water movement on and around your property. New pavement can also be problematic for the township road equipment if it is not installed correctly. A Driveway Permit allows our road crew to prevent problems. \*\*\*\*



Any driveway that is cemented or blacktop must have a 4' to 6' grate at the ditch line the width of the driveway. (See above drawing)

The Roadmaster of Franklin Township has informed me as to the conditions and locations of my driveway, and I agree to all provisions thereof. If the driveway is not put into the Townships specifications, the Roadmaster has a right to deny use of the driveway until it is corrected.
