

February 17, 2025 MEETING

The Franklin Township Board of Supervisors met on Monday, February 17, 2025 at the Township Municipal Building. Those present included Nathan Wulff, Chair of the Board of Supervisors; Joe Schubert, Vice Chair of the Board of Supervisors; Ryan Graham, Supervisor; and Anita Rodgers, Secretary/Treasurer. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Nathan Wulff. There was a moment of silence and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

1. Mark Ansell questioned if there was an ordinance restricting living in a travel trailer in Township
2. Mike Davis, President of the PB-FT VFD, stated that he would be bringing reports to the next meeting

OLD BUSINESS

1. A motion to accept the minutes of the January 6, 2025 Organizational meeting and the Regular Business meeting was made by Nathan, seconded by Ryan and passed unanimously.

A motion to accept all correspondence that was presented at the meeting that did not require further attention or was of little importance not to be named individually on the minutes was made by Nathan, seconded by Ryan and passed unanimously.

A motion to pay the bills and accept the payroll sheets was made by Joe, seconded by Ryan and passed unanimously.

The Board spoke about the following prior to closing the meeting:

- Changes being made to the Zoning Ordinances
- Signing the Township property along SR 528 with the Game Warden which will give the public access to hunt on the property and taking the liability off of the Township
- Ryan Graham announced that he would be running for Supervisor
- Talked about tree trimming/removal along North Road, Unionville Road and Pflugh Road
- Announced that we are in need of 2 Auditors and an Emergency Management Coordinator

There being no further business to discuss, a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Nathan, seconded by Ryan, and passed unanimously.
